- 1. **Intent:** The purpose of this Drill is to simulate the training conditions cadets should expect to encounter when they attend Recruit Training (Bootcamp), with extension training for those who have already attended RT.
- 2. Friday Dinner: All personnel are to eat dinner on Friday before arriving at Camp Lyons. Dinner on Friday is not provided.
- 3. **Transportation:** Cadets may travel with unit staff (departing LPD Training Center at 1700) if there are seats available. If cadets cannot arrive by 1900 LT Montgomery is to be informed.
- 4. Seabag Check: There will be a full seabag inspection at check-in. Please make sure you bring EVERYTHING on the seabag list.
- Check-In: Cadets are to meet at Camp Lyons (aka Four Season Retreat Center) between 1800-1900. Allow time for check-in before muster. PARENTS SHOULD NOT LEAVE UNTIL THE CADET IS FULLY CHECKED IN.
- 6. Medications: Sick call will be conducted after each breakfast and dinner. See the Seabag List for instructions regarding medications.
- 7. Contraband: No contraband will be allowed or tolerated. Contraband is anything not on the Seabag List.
- 8. Supplies: Cadets needing items from the Unit Supply must request NO LATER THAN Wednesday, 11 MAY.
- 9. **PRTs:** PRTs will be conducted for those who still need to complete one for training, or who want to try to improve their scores.
- 10. Directions to Camp Lyons/Four Seasons Retreat Center: 3169 Mud Lick Road, Salt Lick, KY. GPS may not be fully reliable so also follow directions below:

From Lexington: I-64E/I-75 S – take ramp right for I-64E – travel 39.9 mi – take exit 121 – turn right onto Hwy 36 E – travel 7.1 mi – turn left onto Mud Lick Rd/KY-3290 (at the Citgo station) – travel 1 mi – turn right at the Four Seasons sign, follow the road to the top of the hill (total travel time approx. 1 hr from Lexington)
